



## **Trinité Estate 2016**

### **Acaibo, Sonoma County**

**(\$80)** Trinité Estate in Sonoma County's Chalk Hill appellation is run by Claire and Gonzague Lurton, owners of three Grand Crus Classés in Margaux and Pauillac. Made with fruit grown on clay and volcanic soils, the blend of 72% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Merlot, and

10% Cabernet Franc aged 16 months in French oak barrels. Joined by chalky tannins, dried violets, licorice, and orange peel make for extravagant aromas and flavors. Dark chocolate-covered cherry rises from the earth, creating a sweet and voluptuous effect on the palate. **95**
